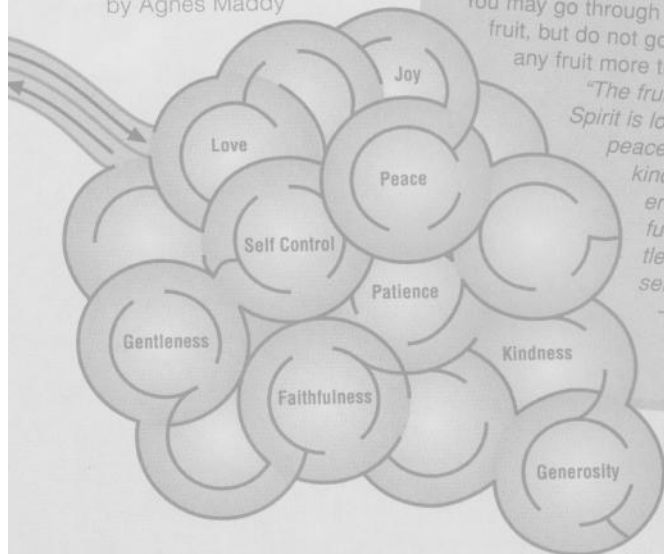


PICK THIS FRUIT!

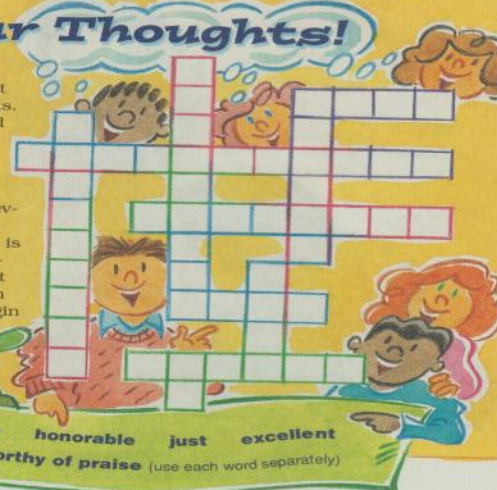

Choose Your Thoughts!

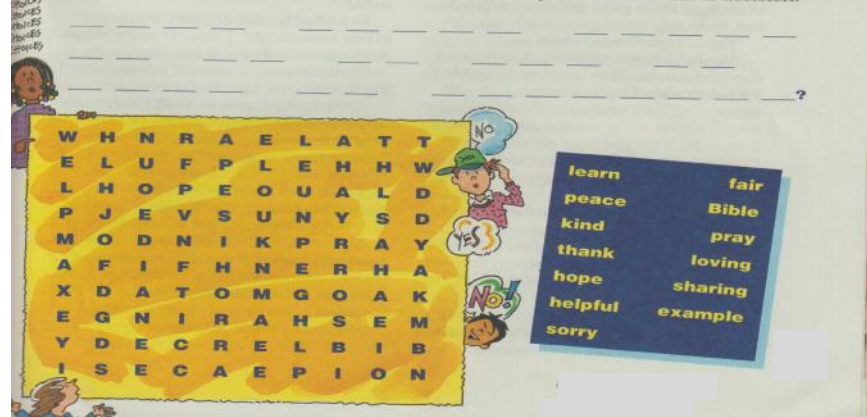
