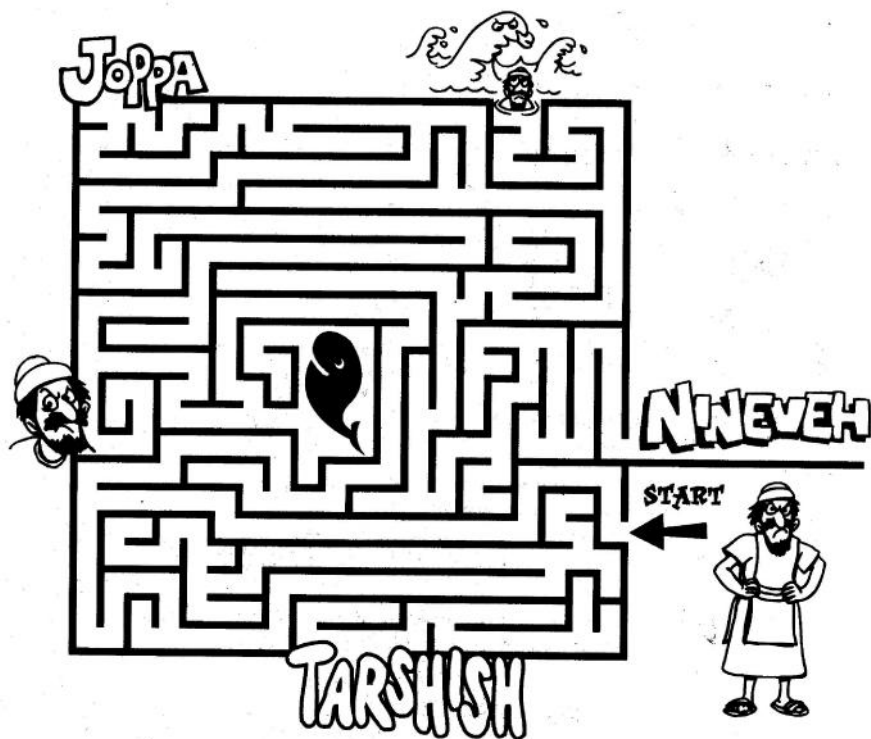


Jonah

RESPONSIBILITY

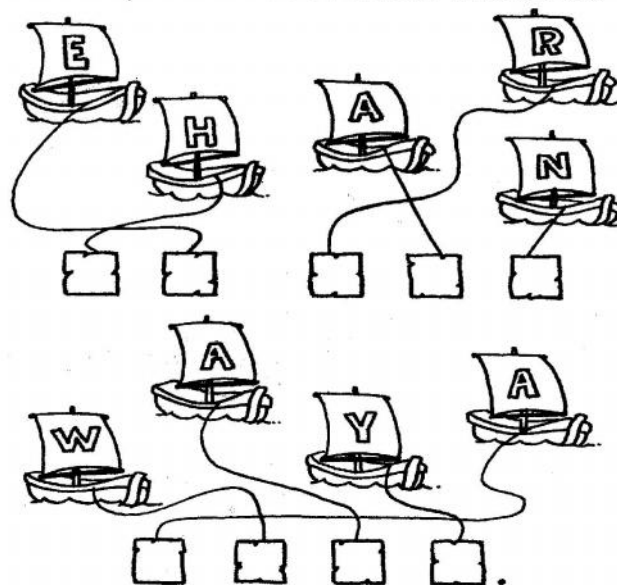
Fulfilling your commitments shows that you are responsible.
